

ARBTA Teacher Registration Policy

Aims and Objectives

- To safeguard, protect and promote the system, style and traditions of the Russian school.
- Provide training programme of studies and examinations from Preliminary through to Advanced and Professional Levels
- Provide for training and examinations of teachers from student to fellowship levels.
- Arrange a minimum of two seminars or workshops per annum to support teachers.
- Monitor teaching standards at examinations, seminars and workshops.
- Monitor the registration of teachers and student teachers through the membership application process to ensure members abide with current legislative requirements.

Membership Policy

Membership shall be open to anyone who wishes to promote the aims and objectives of ARBTA and:

- Holds valid qualifications in the disciplines in which they intend to enter examinations (either qualifications with ARBTA before 2021 or recognised teaching qualification at Level 4 with an accredited organisation)
- Or, will start a recognised Level 4 teaching qualification with GQAL within 12 months of affiliation.

Membership is payable by the 10th January and must be renewed each year. Only fully paid up members can enter students into examinations or advertise their membership with ARBTA.

ARBTA will operate a Teachers Registration scheme (renewable on a 2 year rolling programme) to ensure teachers entering candidates for GQAL Examinations are:

- o DBS Checked every 2 years
- o hold valid First Aid certification
- o attend regular CPD events

The Board of Directors may decline to allow a member to renew their subscription having followed the procedures below:

- An Initial warning has been given in relation to standard or method of teaching, or any other behaviour which is deemed to reflect against ARBTA's aims and objectives.
- A final written decision is sent setting out the reasons for the cancellation or non renewal of a members subscription

The member dismissed shall have the Right of Appeal to the Board of Directors.
